




Activity: Iskcon Temple Visit at Kharghar

Venue: Kharghar, Navi Mumbai

Date & Time: 17th February 2025 , 10.00 am to 4.30 pm.

Detailed Report:

An educational visit was organized to the ISKCON (International Society for Krishna Consciousness) Temple located in Kharghar, Navi Mumbai, as part of our co-curricular enrichment program by Asst. Prof G.Subhashini. The visit aimed to provide a blend of spiritual, cultural, and educational exposure to the students, promoting holistic development outside the traditional classroom setting.

The group assembled and departed at Kharghar Station and after that we reach the temple approximately around 10:00 am

Guided Orientation: Dr Vaishnavanghri director of the Iskcon temple & CEO of polymer company welcomed us and conducted a guided orientation by explaining:

- History of the ISKCON movement
- Teachings of Srila Prabhupada
- Significance of the temple's deities and architecture

He explained every detail related to Sri Sri Radha Madanmohan Ji, who was the founder of this temple.



Spiritual Engagement:

- Students participated in a bhajan (devotional singing) session and observed *aarti* (ritual offering)
- By chanting the mantra the **Hare Krishna Maha Mantra** written in **Hindi (Devanagari script)** as shown below:

हरे कृष्ण हरे कृष्ण
कृष्ण कृष्ण हरे हरे
हरे राम हरे राम
राम राम हरे हरे

Lunch (Prasadam):

- A pure vegetarian lunch (*prasadam*) was also served to us .
- The meal was prepared with hygiene and spiritual sanctity, following ISKCON's principles of *sattvic* food.

Feedback & Interaction:

- An informal discussion was held post-lunch where students shared their thoughts and experiences plus we read shlok written in Bhagwat Geeta and they also provided Bhagwat Geeta books to the students in different languages.

Return: The group departed for Iskcon temple at around 4:30 pm.

Outcome:-

- **Cultural Awareness:** Students gained a deeper understanding of Indian spiritual traditions and religious practices.
- **Value-based Learning:** Exposure to teachings focused on non-violence, service, and humility contributed to moral development.
- **Community Engagement:** Students appreciated the voluntary work and service mindset of temple staff and devotees.
- **Mindfulness & Reflection:** The serene atmosphere encouraged students to reflect on their inner values and purpose.
- **Team Bonding:** The group activity strengthened peer interaction and cooperation among students and faculty.
