

Details of the reports :

Ms. Hemalatha conducted a seminar as part of the National Girl Child Day celebration. During her talk, she highlighted the struggles women have faced throughout history and how their contributions continue to be undervalued in both family and society.

She motivated the girls to believe in their potential, stand up for their rights, and take control of their future. Drawing examples from the *Ramayana* and *Mahabharata*, she emphasized the strength, courage, and dignity of women in ancient times, inspiring students to become confident and empowered individuals.

She also spoke about the importance of women taking care of both their **physical and mental health**. She emphasized that in the process of fulfilling responsibilities at home, work, and society, women often neglect their own well-being. Ms. Hemalatha highlighted that **a healthy mind and body are essential** for women to thrive and contribute meaningfully to their personal and professional lives.

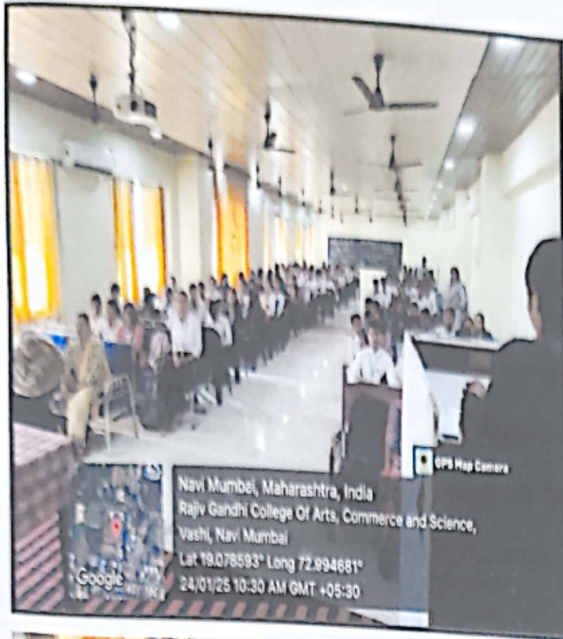
She encouraged the students to **adopt healthy lifestyle habits**, maintain a balanced diet, exercise regularly, and take time for self-care.

- The session fostered a sense of **self-worth and confidence** among students, motivating them to take charge of their futures.

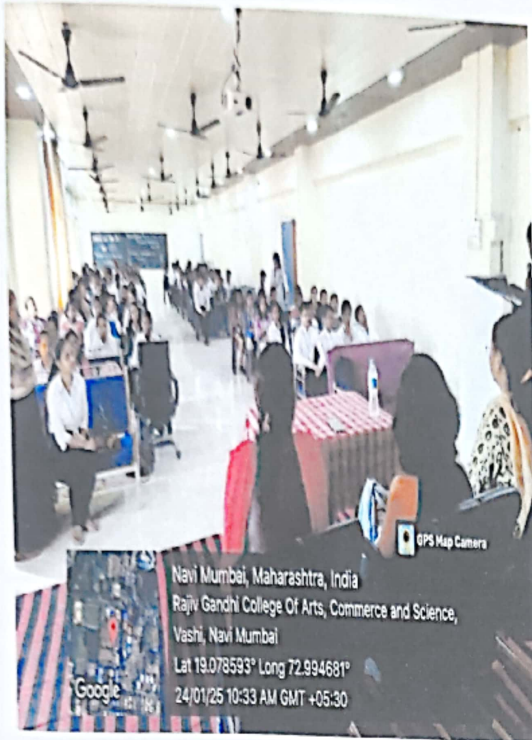

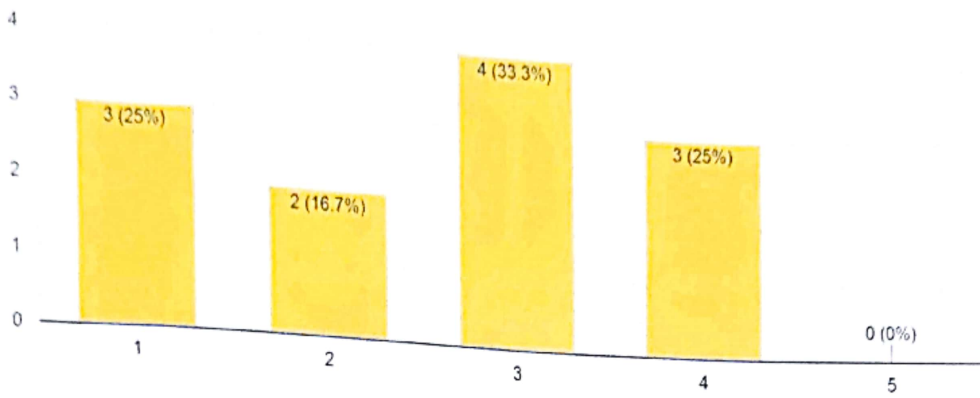
